Mr. Richardson was an urban planner with the Winston-Salem/Forsythe Planning Board for one year. He has also worked in various management positions with several mining operations in the United States. Richardson moved to Beaufort County in 1980 and currently owns a consulting firm offering engineering and surveying services.

Both will serve a three-year term ending September 30, 2012. In addition to Hardy, Gray and Richardson the other trustees are: Alice Sadler, Curtis Potter, Grace Bonner, Allen Roberson, Dr. Sandy Easley, and Jack Piland.
